| Refuse treatment and medication. |  | <p>You cannot refuse treatment that is court ordered, or treatment needed to prevent serious physical harm to yourself or others.</p> |
| Access information about your rights. |  |  |
| File a grievance at any time. |  |  |
| Be represented by an attorney; a full court hearing; to be present at the hearing. | N/A |  |
| Be treated in the least restrictive manner. |  |  |
| Make decisions about your treatment and be informed about the care being provided. |  |  |
| Be evaluated within 72 hours if you are placed on an emergency detention or 72-hour hold. | N/A | <p>For emergency hospitalization.</p> |

Protected from assault or battery.



Receive visitors.



Make and receive confidential phone calls.



Be informed of any costs of your care and treatment that you or your loved ones may have to pay.



Exercise religious worship within the facility.



Consult a physician of your choice.

You will have to pay for it.

Physician from outside facility: you pay. Second opinion from another physician inside the facility: facility must provide at no cost.
